RESULT OF VOTE ON STAFFING RECOMMENDATION: Here are the results of the staffing vote taken last Sunday. A total of 154 people voted. Of these, 87% (134 ballots) voted in favor of forming a search committee to find an associate pastor. There were 3% (5 ballots) abstaining or signing without casting a vote. There were 10% (15 ballots) casting "no" votes.

As a result, Council will now proceed with naming a search committee to begin the process of identifying an associate pastor candidate.
